

Claim your qualifying tuition money.

Simply apply to DeVry University

- Ask your admissions representative to assist you in applying for a scholarship
- Application fee and tuition deposit must be paid at time of application
- Scholarship winners will be notified by mail
- All scholarships are applied to tuition for the total number of terms in a student's chosen program
- Scholarship recipients are responsible for housing costs, book and supply charges and all other fees
- If recipients qualify for more than one scholarship, they will be awarded the higher scholarship amount
- Additional continued eligibility requirements are outlined in the scholarship terms and conditions document received by scholarship winners

To qualify, recipients must also:

- Provide outlined scholarship documentation to admissions representative prior to starting class
- Be a U.S. or Canadian citizen or a permanent resident and attend Campus/Center in respective residential country
- Meet DeVry entrance requirements
- Begin DeVry within one calendar year of graduating from high school or earning a state-issued GED certificate, depending on scholarship type. All June 2008 graduates must begin classes by 2009 spring term
- Submit unofficial transcripts
- Additional criteria may apply. Please consult admissions representative for the application details and requirements

Presidential Scholarship

- DeVry University offers a highly competitive Presidential Scholarship valued at up to \$32,500 or half tuition per semester
- Two scholarships are available per DeVry Campus and two for DeVry Online

Criteria

- Student must be a Dean's Scholarship winner by March 9, 2009 to be eligible
- Minimum CGPA of 3.33 and be in the top 50% of their class
- ACT/SAT composite score of 24 or higher, or combined math and critical reading score of 1100 or higher. (Canadian students must have a CPT composite score of 430 or higher).

Dean's Scholarship

- Valued at up to \$13,500 or \$1,500 per semester, as an opportunity for outstanding students
- We offer this opportunity to every high school student who meets the admission and academic requirements of the scholarship

Criteria

- ACT/SAT composite score of 24 or higher, or combined math and critical reading score of 1100 or higher (Canadian students must have a CPT composite score of 430 or higher).

DeVry High School Scholarship

- Valued at \$9,000 or \$1,000 per semester, for all students who demonstrate a solid academic background coupled with an admirable conviction to pursue their college degree at DeVry University
- Five available per accredited high school in the U.S. and Alberta, Canada until the metro reaches a maximum of 150 total award winners

Criteria

- Students must either be in the top 50% of their class or have a 2.7 CGPA on a 4.0 scale by the end of their junior year to qualify
- Students must have nomination form completed by high school guidance counselor or principal

Deadline

Deadline for nominations/applications for this scholarship must be received by June 21, 2009.

Cisco/CompTIA Scholarship

- Valued at \$10,800 or \$1,200 per semester, awarded to outstanding information technology students
- Offered to every high school student who meets the admission and scholarship requirements

Criteria

- Certification is required in one of the following areas, and students are required to be in enrolled in one of the following specific degree programs in order to be eligible:
 - IT Essentials I Certificate of Completion
 - CCNA Semester I Certificate of Completion
 - CCNET Certification
 - CCDA Certification
 - CCNP Certification
 - CCDP Certification
 - CCIE Certification
 - CompTIA A+ Certification
