

Dean's Scholarship: Total Value \$13,500

- Student must be a senior in high school.
- Student must be an accepted DeVry University applicant.
- Student must have a combined score of 1100 on his/her SAT in math and critical reading **OR** a composite score of 24 on the ACT.
