



IMMUNIZATION RULES FOR 6th GRADE STUDENTS

ALL CHILDREN ENTERING 6th GRADE
(ON OR AFTER July 1, 2007) ARE
REQUIRED TO MEET THE FOLLOWING
NEW REQUIREMENTS:

Have two (2) doses of Varicella (chicken pox) vaccine or documentation of disease or laboratory proof of immunity. Previously, children entering school were required to have only one (1) dose of this vaccine.

All students must still meet the following Requirements:

- 1) Have two (2) doses of Measles vaccine, two (2) doses of Mumps vaccine, and one (1) dose of Rubella vaccine or laboratory proof of immunity against Measles, Mumps or Rubella.
- 2) Have three (3) doses of Hepatitis B vaccine.
